

Lesson plan: Categories of Tawhid

You will need; a whiteboard, different coloured markers, Kitab ul Tawhid, the printable worksheets, coloured pencils/highlighters, a copy of the Translation of the Qur'an, and a copy of the Hadith of Jibreel which can be found here:

- 1) Revisit and read the Hadith of Jibreel again.
- 2) Brainstorm the first part of the Hadith – Islam (Revision).
- 3) Brainstorm the second part of the Hadith – Iman **(Main focus)**
- 4) Discuss the meaning of Iman.
- 5) Circle Allah and draw an arrow for Tawhid. Explain the meaning of Tawhid.
- 6) Discuss the opposite of Tawhid – Shirk. Draw an arrow opposite Tawhid for Shirk.
- 7) Discuss why it is important to learn about Tawhid.
- 8) Brainstorm some of the virtues of Tawhid.
- 9) Worksheets (One by one)
 - Introduce the category (Ruboobiyyah, Uloohiyah, Asma was Siffat), understand and memorise its definition.
 - Write down the meaning.
 - Make a small poster to illustrate i.e. Tawheed Al Uluhiyah could show someone making dua/salaah (no faces of course).
- 10) Ask children to look through the Qur'an and find ayaat which mention Tawheed.
